

New Academic Regulation

Restriction limiting undergraduate students to a maximum of three regular terms to complete the Freshman level.

Academic Regulation: Undergraduate students shall be limited to a maximum of three regular terms to complete the Freshman level, including any dropped, withdrawn, or no-show term. Limiting completion to three terms will ensure timely progression, promote academic continuity, and support graduation within the prescribed timeframe.

Action: Undergraduate students who do not complete the Freshmen level within three regular terms, including dropped, withdrawn, or no-show terms shall be subject to dismissal at the end of the third regular term.
